Privacy Notice - Data Protection Act 1998

The Barclay School is the Data Controller for the purposes of the Data Protection Act. We collect information from you and may receive information about you from your previous school. We hold this personal data and use it to:

- support your teaching and learning;
- monitor and report on your progress;
- provide appropriate pastoral care; and
- assess how well your school is doing.

This information includes your contact details, national curriculum assessment results, attendance information, characteristics such as ethnic group, special educational needs and any relevant medical information.

Connexions Services – Once you are aged 13 or over we are required to pass on certain information to the Connexions services. Connexions is the Government's information and advice service for all young people aged 13 to 19 in England and in Hertfordshire it is branded Youth Connexions and is part of the Children, Schools and Families Department within Hertfordshire County Council.

We must provide both your name and address and those of your parent/carer(s) and any further information relevant to the Connexions services' role.

However, you (if you are over 16) or your parent/carer(s) can ask that no information beyond name and address be passed to Connexions. Please inform the School's Database Manager if you wish to opt-out of this arrangement. For more information about Connexions please phone 01992 901515. Other Institutions involved in collaborative delivery – Where secondary schools are involved in collaborative delivery with other schools/colleges and learning providers pupil information may also be shared to aid the preparation of learning plans and use of data to achieve the objectives identified above.

We will not give information about you to anyone outside the school without your consent unless the law and our rules permit it.

We are required by law to pass some of your information to the Local Authority (LA) and the Department for Children, Schools and Families (DCSF).
