Students will normally select **four** subjects, one from each column, though many will select five.

All students must have a minimum of 15 'contact hours' on their timetable – most will have around 20. This includes a weekly meeting for the year as a whole and regular tutorial guidance sessions on a one-to-one basis.

Please note that students who score a D grade or lower in GCSE English or Maths will be required to retake the GCSE qualification [if scoring a D] or to follow a course in Functional Skills.
